Our facility provides anesthetic monitoring, pain management and pre-anesthetic blood tests for all our patients. Below are the following tests and options recommended for your pet's health prior to or during an anesthetic or surgical procedure.

		RADIO-SURGERY USAGE: Radio-surgery usage during certain surgical procedures minimizes bleeding and fluid loss, thus lowering the risk of anesthesia. Checking Yes in this slot will allow radio-surgery usage if the Doctor deems appropriate.	\$35.00 to \$85.00
		PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOOD SCREEN (BASIC OR SENIOR): Checking Yes here allows the Doctor to perform blood tests used to assess the function of organs, i.e., the liver and kidneys that are vital to metabolizing anesthetics. The Senior panel incorporates additional tests which are especially pertinent to older pets and those with illness.	JUNIOR (<7 yrs) \$72.00 SENIOR (>7 yrs) \$92.00
		ECG: Checking Yes here will allow the Doctor to perform a short procedure to help assure your pet's heart rhythm and function are normal prior to anesthesia.	\$39.00
		COMBINATION PACKAGE (JUNIOR OR SENIOR): This package includes a Pre-anesthetic Screening together with an ECG. This is the most complete option for pre-anesthetic testing. Checking Yes here will allow the Doctor to perform the Pre-anesthetic Screening and ECG at a 10% savings to you.	JUNIOR (<7 yrs) \$111.00 SENIOR (>7 yrs) \$131.00
		OCCULT HEARTWORM TEST: Heartworms are potentially deadly parasites that live within the heart. They interfere with normal blood flow and can cause severe anesthetic complications. This test is needed every two years or if your pet is not currently on heartworm preventative. Checking Yes here will allow for a heartworm test to be performed on your pet.	\$50.00
		IV TKO (Intravenous – To Keep Open) Checking Yes here gives your Doctor permission to install an IV catheter for intra-operative fluids. This assures ready access to blood vessels and allows your veterinarian to optimize pain management.	\$35.00
		SQ Fluids (Pre-operative Subcutaneous Fluids) – Benefits are similar to intravenous fluids, but in smaller patients where catheterization is not possible, those fluids help optimize hydration & blood pressure while under anesthesia.	<30cc \$18.00 >30cc \$28.00
		MICROCHIP IDENTIFICATION: The Avid Microchip is a permanent form of identification that is Nationally recognized and has been effective at returning many a lost pet to their owners. Checking Yes here will allow our Doctor to administer Microchip Identification.	\$49.00
